The time has arrived once again for us to open up our Mass intention book for the next six months. We continue to maintain the beautiful tradition of having Masses offered for our loved ones, especially those who have died. The process has not changed, as we aim to ensure fairness in scheduling Mass intentions.

**We ask that you use the enclosed form to list your intention requests.** If you need extra space, use the back of the form. Fill out both halves of the form and keep the bottom half (duplicate) for your records. This is your “receipt.”

Forms should be **mailed back or dropped off during office hours.** Requests will be considered in the order they are received.

We will call you if we are unable to fulfill a request (e.g., if it is already taken, or there is no Mass on the date requested).

**If you do not receive a call, this means that all of your requests have been accepted.**

**For this initial period, we will not be accepting Mass intention requests by phone.** Beginning Monday, December 6, phone requests will be accepted.

**Please note:**

- You may request up to **two weekend (Saturday evening or Sunday morning) Mass intentions.**
- **Weekday Masses** are on Tuesday and Friday evenings at 7 pm. There is no limit to the number of intentions you can request. However, be advised that we accept **multiple intentions** (up to five) for these Masses. All of the names will be announced at Mass, and these intentions will receive the same spiritual benefit.
- We are opening up intentions for **six months (January 1 through June 30, 2022)**, in keeping with the practice in all the parishes served by the Raritan Oratory, and also to reduce the burden on parish staff who process the requests.

Again, thank you for continuing to participate in this beautiful tradition, in which we reaffirm our faith in the graces of Christ's sacrifice, made present and effective for those for whom we pray when we offer Mass.
